

**Important SNESL Tuition Remission Information for
School Year 2009-2010**

LSAT Remission

If you currently receive LSAT remission, please refer to your admissions letter as to your requirements to continue in this program.

Students in their first year will receive their remission for the entire academic year, before their GPA is evaluated for continuation. The academic year ends after the summer semester.

All subsequent years, remission is evaluated/applied after grades/GPA's are available.

ONCE LSAT REMISSION IS LOST, YOU DO NOT GET IT BACK!

GPA Remission

SNESL currently has a program in place to reward your hard work!

If you are a returning student and have an 80.1 to 84.9 cumulative GPA, you will receive 10% remission off your next semester's tuition charges.

If you are a returning student and have an 85 or higher cumulative GPA, you will receive 25% remission off your next semester's tuition charges.

GPA remission is evaluated for ALL returning students after grades are in and GPA's calculated.

You must have had a normal course load, as defined in the Student Handbook, in your past semester (at least 8 credits) to be eligible.

First year students are not eligible for GPA remission.

LSAT & GPA Remission

If you are a returning student receiving LSAT remission, you do qualify for GPA remission as well!

You will receive both, not to exceed 50% total remission.
